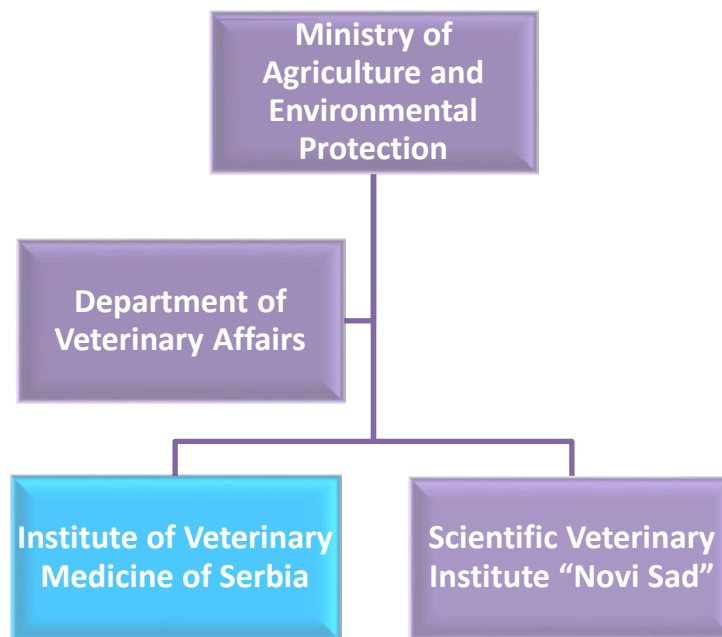

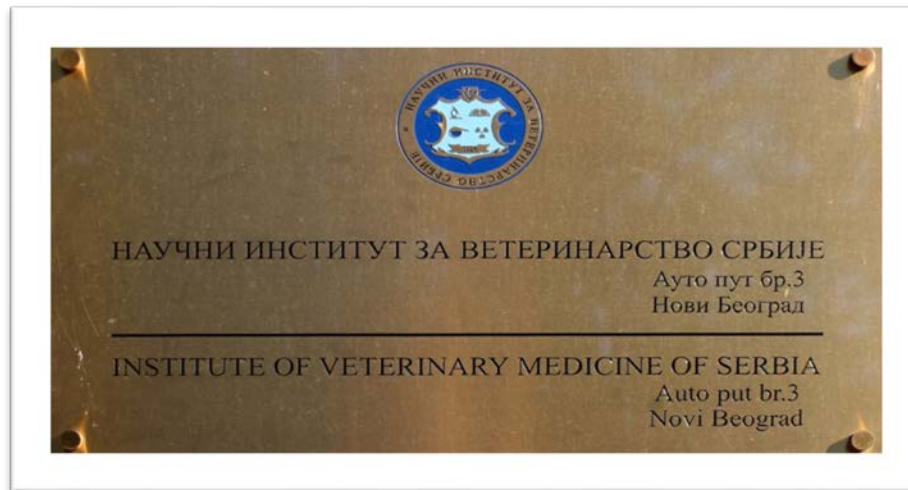

Institute of Veterinary Medicine of Serbia

- Was formed on 11 February 1926. under the name Central Veterinary Bacteriological Institute. Institute had the task of testing the vaccine (vaccination) and diagnosis of bacterial, viral and parasitic diseases of animals. In addition, experts from the Institute are coming out into the field to establish and control of livestock diseases. In addition to its regular activities, the experts of the Institute have studied and enlightenment of farmers and kept regularly lectures on cattle infections in radio station in Belgrade.



After the end of World War II on the initiative of the Ministry of Agriculture Republic of Serbia and acting Chief Veterinary administration organized Veterinary Bacteriological Institute NR Serbia. In 1947, the Institute moved to Voždovac - street Bulevar Stepe no. 295, where he stayed until 1982. From this, the Institute is moving at two locations in Belgrade.

Today's Scientific Veterinary Institute of Serbia is one of the leading scientific and professional institutions in the field of veterinary medicine. It consists of the Institute for Health Care and the Institute of Food and Drug.

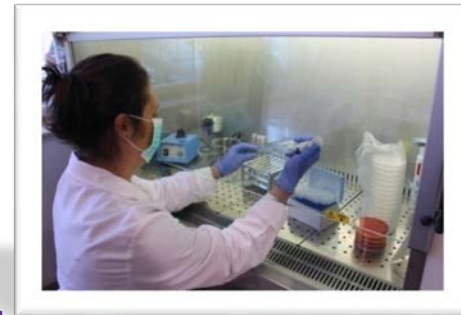

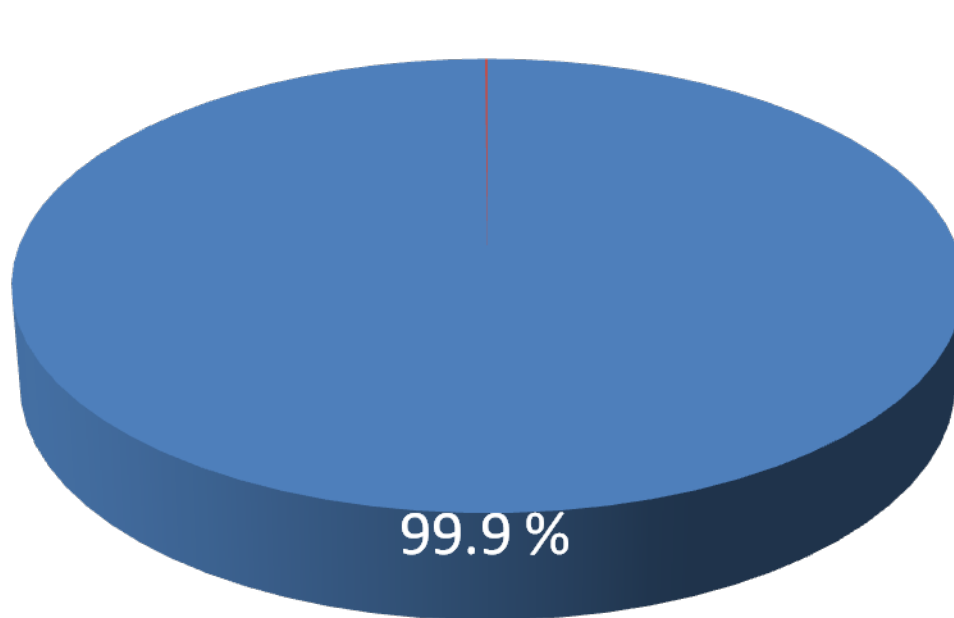

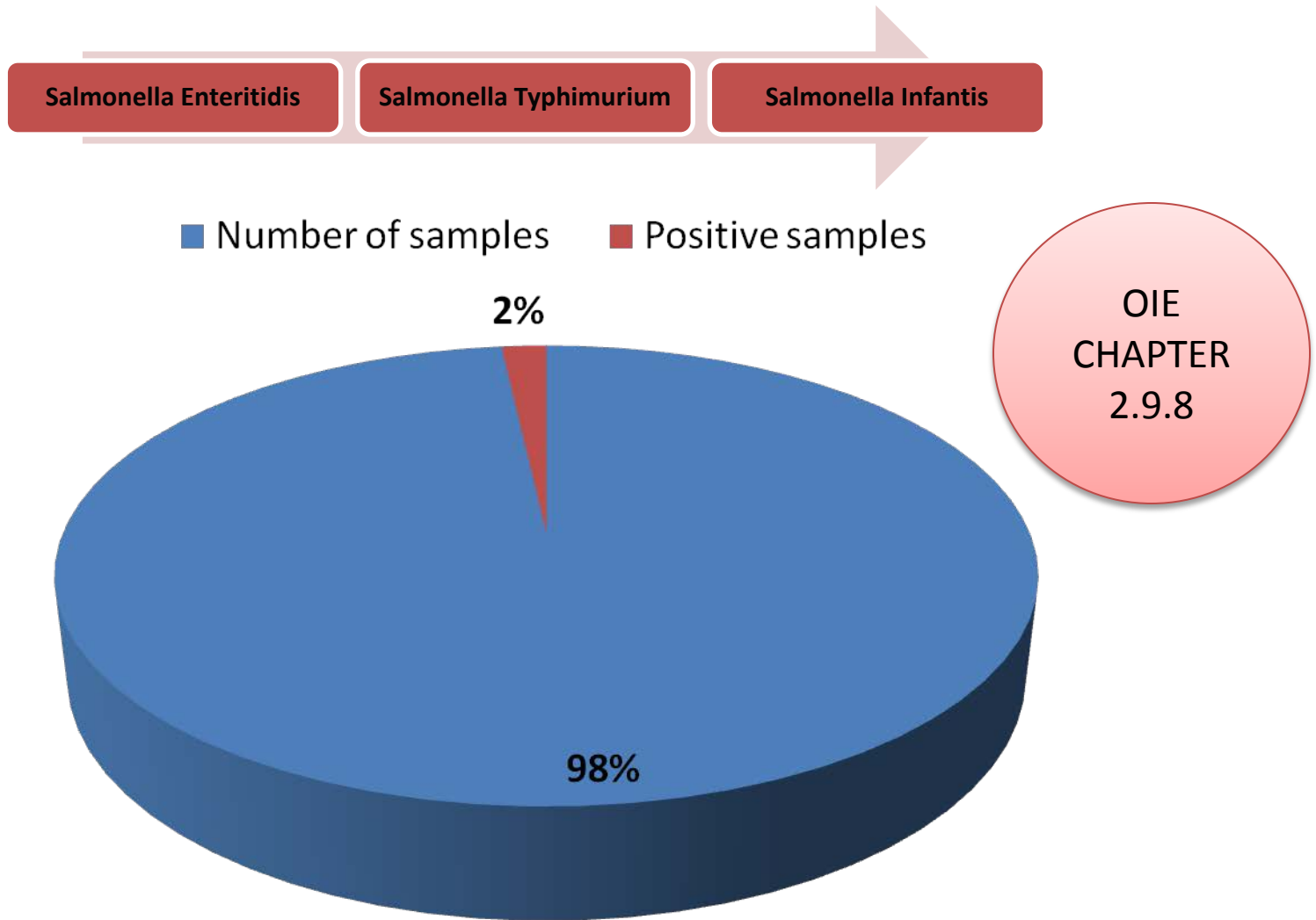
