
Guidelines during online meeting

 Post the (full) question or indicate 'floor please'












Information online EURL-Salmonella workshop 2021


Evaluation 25th workshop 2020 First online workshop






Did you face technical problems?


Opinion on length of meeting and no. of breaks



Instead of typing the question in the chat, one could give a sign for a question (in the chat) and pose the question orally.'




Opinion on the scientific programme






General opinion of the workshop






Is online workshop good alternative for physical?



Remarks: 'Opportunity for people of multi-disciplines to participate.' 'Physical meetings provide opportunity for networking, online workshops only provides scientific knowledge.' 'It was very good, but physical meetings are better.' 'Consider to organise online workshop every 2 years.' 'Yes, in case a physical meeting is not possible.'
